Ian Adair grew up in Oklahoma City, one of two sons raised by a single parent. He actively experienced life below the poverty level which instilled in him the need to help kids in similar circumstances and those who want to learn to be a better person. In June of

2006, Ian came to Wichita as Chief Professional Officer of the Boys & Girls Clubs of South Central Kansas.

It is because of his past personal and professional experience, those who have worked with Ian can testify to his ability to connect with kids his organization serves and the donors who support it.

Upon his arrival in Wichita, Ian launched a campaign to raise \$8 million for a new, 42,000 square foot facility to be built at 21st & Opportunity. When completed, the Boys & Girls Clubs of South Central Kansas will be able to double the number of kids it serves – from 2,000 to 4,000. Ian says his goal is to serve 5,000

children in one of the most technologically advanced Clubs in the region
